Key Stage Results

2016

Attainment at KS2 under new testing arrangements and criteria: (New scaled scores put expected standard at 100)

Reading: 62% of children achieved the expected standard or above (National 65.6%, Shropshire 67.9%) with a 101.8 average scaled score. (National 102.6, Shropshire 103). 33.3% achieved a high standard.

Writing: 31% of children achieved the expected standard or above (National 74%, Shropshire 68.3%).

Maths: 54% of children achieved the expected standard or above (National 69.7%, Shropshire 69.3%) with an average scaled score of 100.1 (National 103, Shropshire 102.8). 6.7% achieved a high score.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS):

54% achieved the expected standard or above (National 72.4%, Shropshire 69.3%) with an average scaled score of 98.6 (National 104, Shropshire 103.2). 20% achieved a high standard.

Reading, Writing and Maths:

31% of children achieved the expected standard or above (National 53.2%, Shropshire 51.2%).

Early Years Foundation Stage Profile:

36% of children achieved expected and exceeded levels of development. National figures: 69.3%

Phonics Screening Check for Year 1s:

100% of pupils passed the phonics screening check, above the national average of 80.6%.

Phonics Screening Check for Year 2 Re-takes:

25% passed as opposed to 66.7% nationally.

Attainment at KS1 under new testing arrangements and criteria:

Reading: 60% attained the expected standard or better.

Writing: 33% attained the expected standard or better.

Maths: 33% attained the expected standard or better.
