

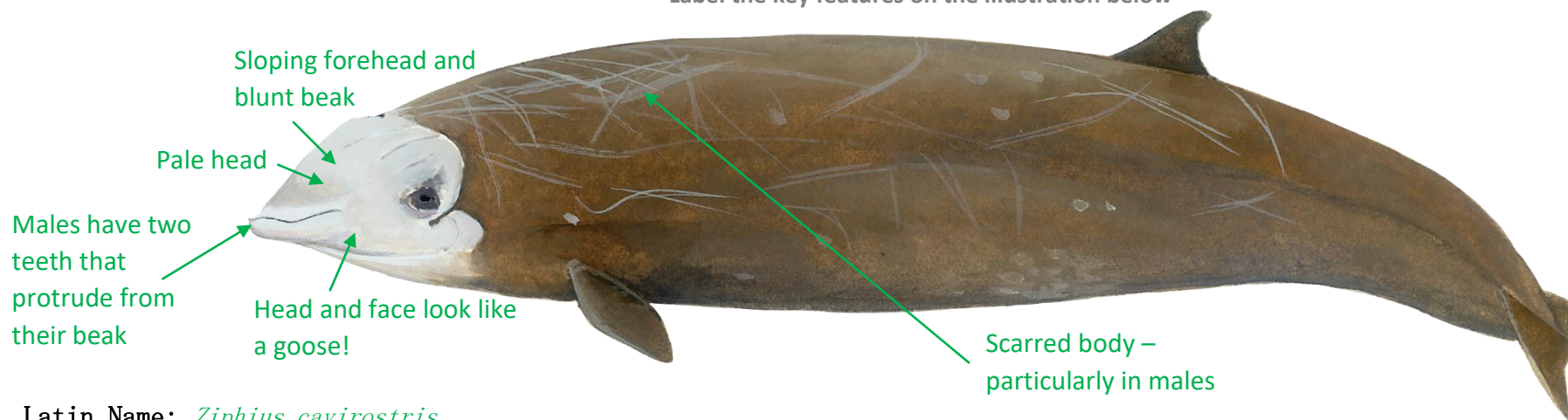

Latin Name: *Ziphius cavirostris*

Size: 5.5 - 7m

Colour: Cuvier's beaked whales have a high variation of colour, ranging from dark grey, to reddish brown, to almost white

Deepest Diving Depth: 2,992m

Can hold its breath for 2 hours and 43 minutes

They travel alone or in groups of 3 to 12

They are a species of toothed / ~~baleen~~ whale (circle the right answer)
