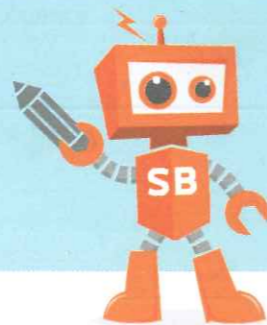


1 Word classes

Different words do different jobs in a sentence. These are called word classes.

| Word class | Definition | Examples |
|---------------------|---|--|
| Nouns | tell you the names of people, places, feelings and things | Rohit, Adrian, Manchester, chair, love |
| Pronouns | replace a noun to avoid repetition | He played on his scooter. That is the best picture. |
| Adjectives | give you more information about a noun | the big dog a blue ball my younger sister |
| Verbs | tell you what is happening in a sentence | She played a game. They are going to the swimming baths. |
| Adverbs | explain when, why or how an action happens | I stroked the dog gently . She won the match yesterday . |
| Conjunctions | connect words, phrases and clauses | Ruby brushed her teeth before she went to bed. If it is raining tomorrow, we will need our umbrellas. |
| Prepositions | show the position of things | He put it under the chair. After supper we went to bed. |
| Determiners | always placed before a noun and help to define it | All children love to play games. The teacher read a book. |
