## Have a lovely summer and key points for September

What a strange time we have had since March! Well done and thank you for all you have done trying to keep learning going at home and keeping in contact with us here at school. I am really pleased that we have managed to get nearly everyone back into school at some point before the Summer Holidays, it has been great to see the children, they have really benefited and are now ready for September and the 'new normal'!

I have written a document: 'Procedures for returning in September' and a Risk Assessment which should both be read before sending your child back in September but these are long documents and I thought I should just do some key reminders for everyone to help make it all easier.

- School uniform should be worn including school shoes. An indoor pair of shoes should be brought in for muddy times outside.
- When pupils know their PE day, they can wear PE kit for the whole day.
- No big bags please, just book bags, water bottles and lunch boxes/bags (if needed).
- Packed lunches are available to order in September at £2.25. Payment via online system.
- Staggered starts are simple: Nursery and Class 1 in at 08:55 and leave at 15:10.  
Class 2 and Class 3 in at 08:45 and leave at 15:15.  
Siblings of Class 2/Class 3 who are in Class 1/Nursery can be in at 08:45 and leave at 15:15.
- Every member of the school community must commit to the NHS test and trace process if required.
- No child should come into school with symptoms of coronavirus: a persistent cough, a temperature or a loss of taste and smell. Testing and isolation should be in place immediately.
- Parents must not congregate at entrances and exits and must follow the one-way system on and off the site maintaining social distancing in line on the 2m markers.
- Every parent must ring school to arrange an appointment and cannot drop into the office unannounced.
- Only one adult to accompany children to and from school.

Hopefully, this all makes sense; all procedures are in place to maintain safety and will be reviewed throughout the term and changed in line with government guidance.
