

Dear parents/carers,

March 8th Return

We are really pleased to be welcoming everyone back to school next week and resuming the school year.

COVID is still prevalent in Shropshire so we do need everyone to be vigilant and if your child shows any of the symptoms of Coronavirus: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a sudden change to their sense of taste or smell then it is important they stay off school until tested. In order to access a test please go to www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or phone 119 immediately and they should be able to support you. If you are concerned about the symptoms shown by your child, keep them and any siblings off and phone 111 or your GP for advice. A negative test would mean your child can return to school and as these tests can be turned around quite quickly, following the route of getting a test is highly recommended. Otherwise, the child with the symptoms needs to isolate for 10 days along with the rest of the household from when the symptoms were first observed. If a positive test result occurs then Public Health England will be informed and the school will be advised how to proceed. Your child will be sent home if they display any symptoms in school and advised to stay away for 10 days or until a negative test is received.

Collection and Drop off:

- One adult only to accompany children onto site. All please wear a mask.
- School will open at **08:45 and close at 15:15**. Registration will close at **08:55**.
- Class 1 and Nursery can be accompanied onto site by one adult and children will be taken or walk in to school from the gate on the car park, whilst the adult goes through the gate and back into Glebe Close.
- Class 2 and 3 can be dropped off at the main gate onto Glebe Close and walk down the pedestrian path where they will be able to go straight into school. Younger pupils in Class 2 could be accompanied to the car park gate if necessary, as children get older we would encourage more independence where possible.
- Please maintain 2m distances when collecting or dropping off.
- Please do not come onto site before the gate is open at 08:45 and 15:15.
- At 15:15 adults to collect Class 1 and Nursery should line up at the pedestrian car park gate and
 your child will be sent or brought to you. Straight after that Class 2 and 3 will be walked out to the
 main school gates onto Glebe Close. Please bear with us if they come out between 15:15 and 15:20.
- As before please collect your child and then take them out across the car park keeping to a social distance of 2m from other parents and adults.







Hot lunches will be available to order daily and must be paid online. The cost is £2:25 per lunch.

Children should not carry big bags and continue to wear their PE kit into school when it is their PE day, the teacher will inform them when there PE day is.

We are hoping to start a KS2 sports club after school on a Monday from the 15th March, further details will follow. Siblings in KS1 would be considered if enough places were available but we need to keep bubbles separate where possible. There will also be a club after school on a Thursday but this is yet to be confirmed and both won't happen in the first week back, details will be sent out over the course of that week though.
