Admissions Policy (Primary Schools)

Cheswardine Primary and Nursery School's current admissions policy is operated by Shropshire Council as local education authority (LA) on behalf of the school.

Whilst it is helpful if parents can let school know at an early date if they would like their children to attend in due course, offers of places can only be confirmed by the LA in the academic year before the child is due to start school.

Our school also provides early years education for children who have reached four years of age, in accordance with regulations in Shropshire's Early Years Development Plan. New reception children may spend three half day sessions in the school arranged in the last few weeks prior to becoming full time pupils.
