

Over the next half term we would like children to complete a project for their homework. Each week they will be expected to spend about 25 minutes working on their project but this can be at a time that suits your family. We will not need to see their weekly progress, but the completed project will need to be submitted on Friday 14th December. Homework should please be presented neatly and written either in pen, (if children have their pen licence) pencil or typed.

The project needs to include a minimum of five of the following suggestions. But completing more, will earn extra dojos!

- Choose a times table that you have learnt and write it out using Roman numerals.
- Create a Roman timeline.
- With permission, watch a film with a Roman theme. Write a film review.
- Find a Roman recipe. Create this recipe and take a photo to show your creation. (Write the recipe to go with your photo in case others would like to have a go).
- Create a poster advertising gladiatorial games at the colosseum.
- Research a Roman town. Present your findings in a factfile. e.g Rome, Chester.
- Design a Roman maze using reflective symmetry.
- Create your own Roman quiz including at least 5 questions. Challenge your family and friends to answer them.
- Design a job advert for a Roman soldier.
- Research a Roman invention that is still used today. E.g. Roads, aqueduct.
