I. Cut out Dino Skip game board and glue together before laminating. (You could also mount the game board on a heavier colored paper for a sturdier board.\} Laminate and cut out Dino Skip cards.
How to Play:
Have the teacher choose a "magic number." This can be any even number between 2 and 20, depending on the level of your students. \{For the most simple version, start with 2 , then try starting with 20 and having students count backwards by 2 s. For an added challenge, try starting with 10 or 14 and then build by 2 's in both directions.
Place Dino Skip cards face-down. Each player picks up 5 cards. The first player must play a card with the "magic number" to start the game. If they have a card with the number, they place it on one of the rectangles on the game board. If they do not have the number, they draw a card. The second player may either play a card with the "magic number" and a different picture, or they may play off of the first player's turn by laying down the card with the same picture and the number that comes next \{or before, depending on your "magic number"\} \{See next page for directions with pictures! :)\}
I. The first player to get rid of all of their cards wins!
