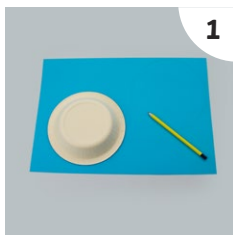


Craft Instructions

Rangoli Window Decoration

Supplies

- Coloured card
- Coloured tissue paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- A pencil
- A circular template (a small paper plate or bowl would do!)
- Ribbon
- Hole punch

First, draw around the circular template onto some coloured card.

Next, cut out the circle of card.

Then, fold the circle in half and then in half again.

After that, cut out one or two shapes along each of the straight edges of the shape.

Then, cut a small triangle out of the corner of the folded shape.

Now, carefully open out your folded shape.

Next, cover one side of the piece of card with some glue, going around the edges of each cut-out shape.

Then, use small pieces of colourful tissue paper to cover the holes.

Now, punch a small hole near the edge of the circle and thread some ribbon through to hang your Rangoli pattern in a window.

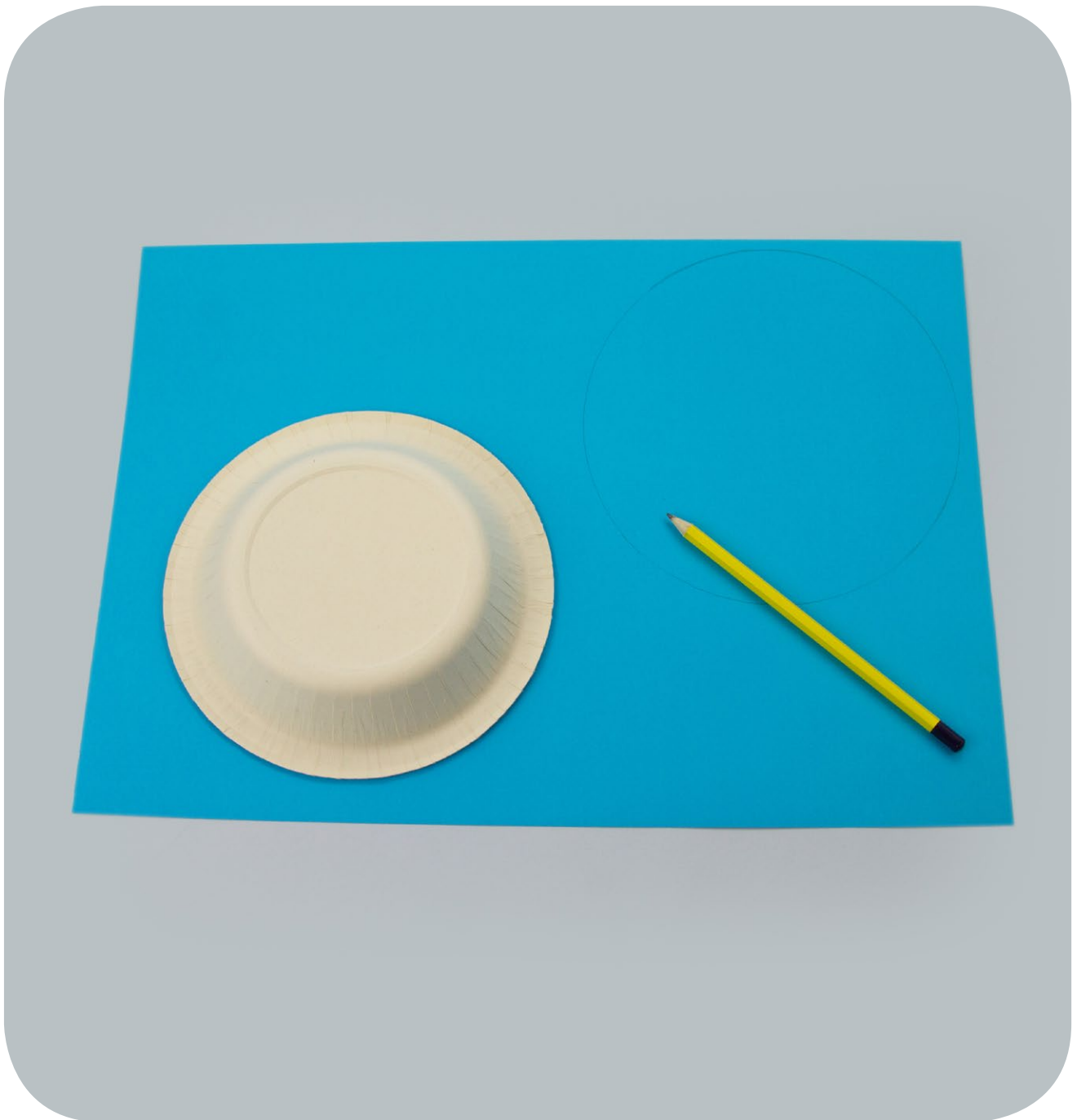
Rangoli Window Decoration

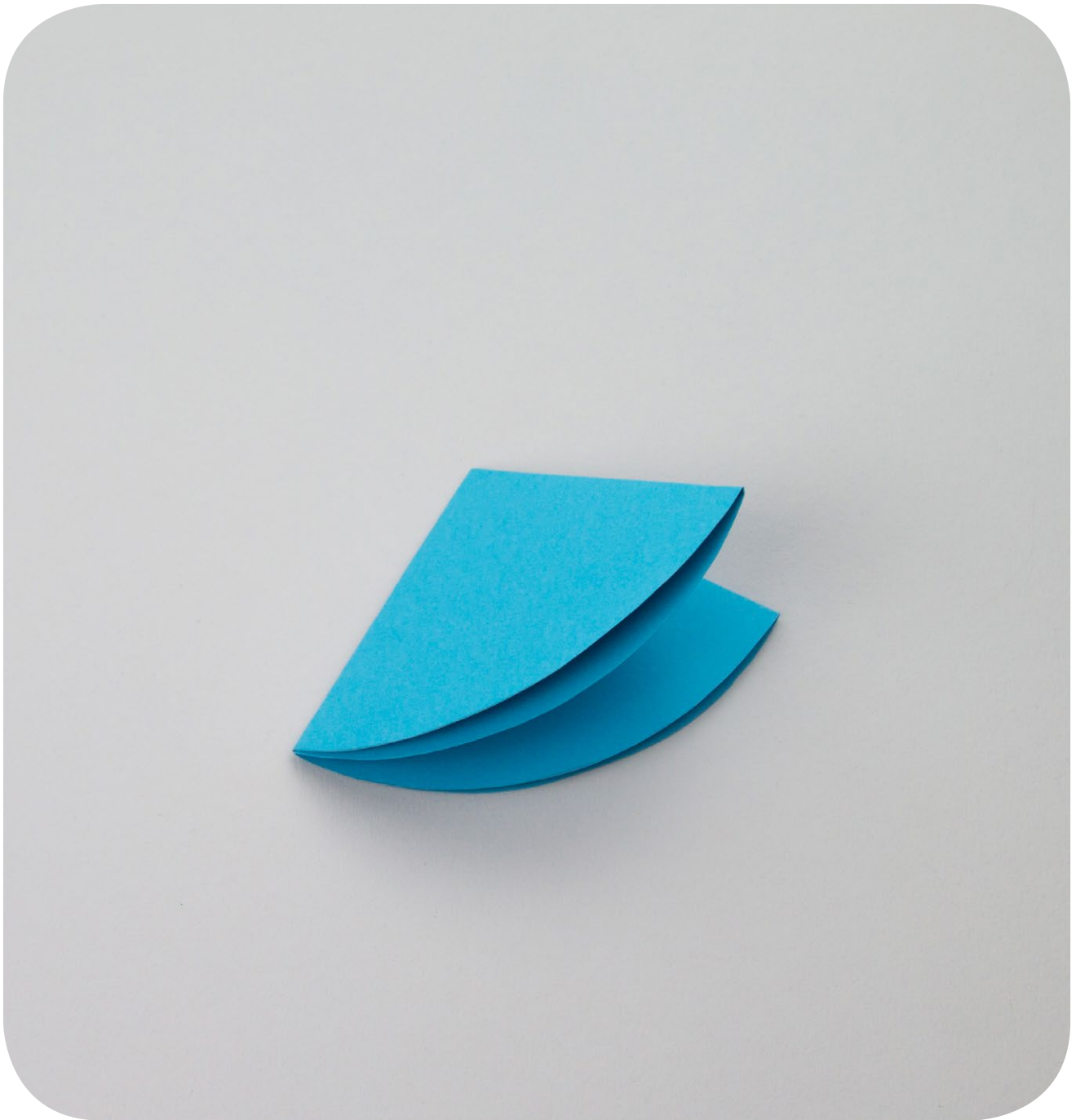




Step 1. First, draw around the circular template onto some coloured card.



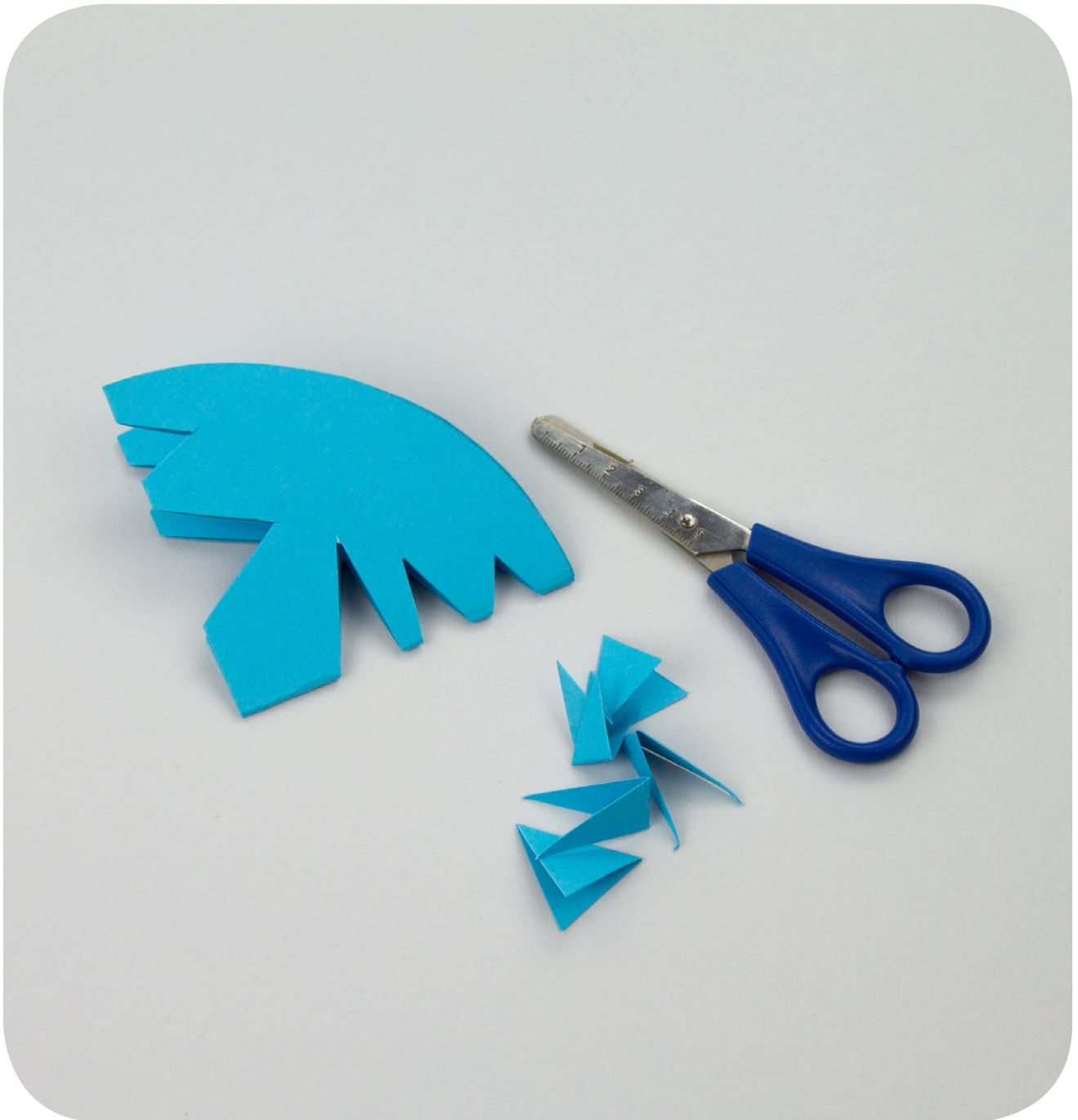
Step 2. Next, cut out the circle of card.
