

Going Fishing!

Teacher Instructions

To prepare the game, cut out the fish from the Going Fishing! Fish Cut-Outs. Bend a paperclip so that it is standing up vertically and stick it to the back of each fish using sticky tack so that the word is facing down.



To make the fishing rods, tie a length of string onto the top of a straw or lolly stick. Tie a paperclip onto the other end of the string and pull the paperclip open slightly to make a hook.



The children must hook a fish and accurately read the word that is on it to be able to keep the fish. If their partner/group feels like they haven't read the word accurately, then they must put the fish back into the 'pond'.

The winner is the person with the most fish at the end of the game.
