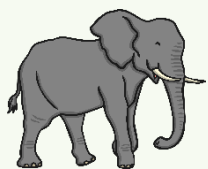

Can you write the plural of these words? Remember, sometimes you need to add -s and sometimes you need to add -es. Can you put the words into the correct jar for their word ending?



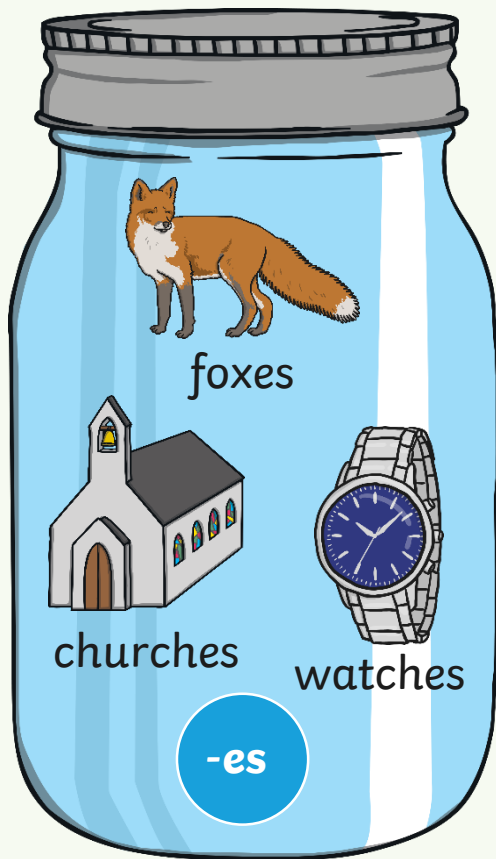

To clean my pet, I use one **brush** → To clean my pet, I use two brushes.

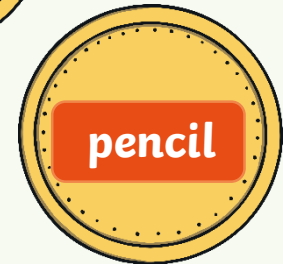
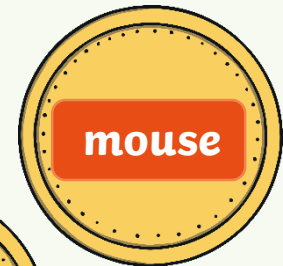
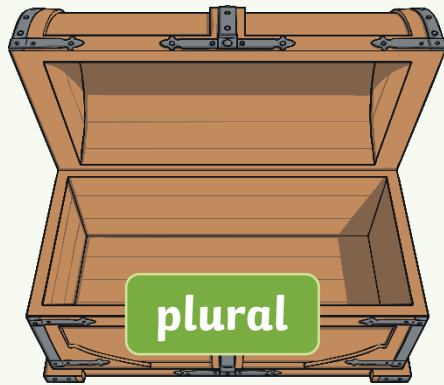

I don't know why she swallowed the fly!

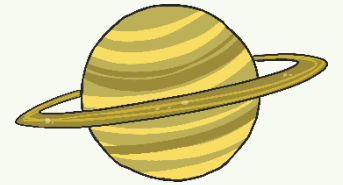
