Paper Plate Angel Christmas Decoration

You will need:

- A paper plate
- White card
- Colourful felt tips
- Glue
- A gold marker
- Gold stars
- A pipecleaner



1) First, cut a section smaller than a quarter from the paper plate.



2) Use your gold marker to decorate the edge of the two parts of your paper plate. Draw lines on the bumps at the edge of the paper plate.



3) Next, use glue to attach the smaller section (the angel's body) to the larger section (the angel's wings). The bottom of the angel's body should sit below the edge of the angel's wings.



4) Then, cut a piece of white card 1.5cm by 8cm. This strip of card will be the angel's arms.









5) Cut two small circles as hands, and glue them to the back of the strip of card. Then glue the arms to the angel body. The arms should be just below the point of the angel body.



6) Next, make a head for your angel. You could use a photograph, or draw a face and hair on your colourful card and cut out. Glue the head onto the point of the angel's body.



7) Add gold stars to the angel's wings and body.



8) Finally, add your angel's halo. Take a pipecleaner and make a loop at one end of the pipcleaner. Twist the pipecleaner to secure the loop. Now turn the angel over and use sticky tape to attach the halo to the back of the angel.
