

English/Phonics:

We will continue to follow the Read Write Inc Scheme.

Children initially learn sounds of letters. This then develops by reading simple words and developing skills to read longer and more challenging words.

Children then use these skills to build interesting sentences.

Handwriting:

Year 1/2 are beginning to practise cursive handwriting in daily handwriting sessions.
