

English/Phonics:

As our theme this term is fairy tales, we will be diving into traditional tales and modern alternatives.

Some of these include:

The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson

The last wolf by Mini Grey – Little Red Riding Hood

In Phonics, we continue to follow the same Read Write Inc. programme. This term some children will complete the Phonics screening check. We will be sending practise home as well to give children the chance to do their best.
