In the afternoon our Nursery leavers will be celebrating their Nursery time with a party to which parents are invited.

Then it will be the last day of term on 19.7.22. Children return to school on Tuesday 6th September for a new term in new year groups. As we are pretty much back to normality after our pandemic disruptions there are a few expectations that now need to be more strongly enforced or changed.

As a school we will continue to have PE on Monday and Friday afternoons. All children should come to school in PE kit but this must be school PE kit so that we are all a team and are still wearing a uniform. 
Support is available if you are in receipt of pupil premium.

If a track suit is needed this should consist of plain navy jogging bottoms and the school sweatshirt or fleece on top of the PE top. No bright colours or logo covered tops would be acceptable. Children will be asked to change into alternative school kit which is in school if they arrive without it. School shoes should be black and sturdy and trainers should be brought in everyday as alternative outdoor shoes although they can be worn into school on PE days. The school colours should be worn at all times, school logo is preferred but plain tops are acceptable as alternatives in the school colours. Summer dresses are blue and white checked. Please support us in ensuring consistency across the school in sport and general dress to ensure the team atmosphere in school.

We are also now in the position to begin trialling wraparound care at Cheswardine. We will currently be able to offer 5 breakfast clubs from 07:45- 08:45 at a cost of £4 each and four after school clubs on a Monday to Thursday until 5pm costing £6. There will be a 10% sibling discount and if taking part in after school activities until 4:15pm the children will be charged £3 to remain until 5pm. We hope that uptake will grow and will be trialling the care until Christmas in the first instance. Bookings for the month will be requested in advance and payment taken prior to the start of the month through our online payment

I do go between the two schools and the days in Cheswardine vary but I am always (barring uncontrollable incidences) there on a Friday morning.
