



RE- WHAT DO CHRISTIANS LEARN FROM THE CREATION STORY?



RECAP

What is Christianity? Believe in God/Jesus/Holy Spirit, Bible is the Holy Book.

Pentecost- beginning of Christianity.

CRUCIAL KNOWLEDGE

The Creation story in Christianity is the first story on a timeline of the Bible.

Sequence key events from the Creation story. (1st Light was created, 2nd the sky was created, 3rd dry land, seas, plants and trees were created, 4th the sun, moon and stars were created, 5th creatures that live in the sea and fly in the sky were created, 6th animals and humans were created and on the 7th day He rested.)

Give examples of how Christians act as stewards for God's creation. (Environmental work, caring for animals and people, keeping oceans clean, sustainability)

Explain the story of the fall, Genesis 3. (Adam and Eve being tempted by the serpent and eating the forbidden fruit.)

Give examples of how Christians ask for forgiveness from God. (Prayer, song)

EXTENDED KNOWLEDGE

Demonstrate an understanding of what Christians believe God is like from Genesis 1:1-2:3 and from the story of the fall, Genesis 3. (Omniscient, omnipotent, omnipresent.)

KEY VOCABULARY

Creator/Creation	Someone who made something/ Something which has been made.	Stewardship	The job of supervising or taking care of something.
Faith	Complete trust in someone or something.	Genesis	First book in the Bible, meaning, 'origins.'
Omnipotent, omniscient, omnipresent	All powerful, all knowing, always present.	Sustainability	The ability to maintain at a certain rate or level.
God	In Christianity, the creator.	Gratitude	Being thankful, readiness to show appreciation.
Belief	An acceptance that something is true or present even without proof.	Repentance	Sincere regret or remorse, asking for forgiveness.
