Recognise sources of light. It is not safe to look directly at the sun, even with sunglasses. Shadows are formed when light is blocked. You need light in order to see.

CRUCIAL KNOWLEDGE

Translucent means some light can pass through. Opaque materials do not let light pass through.

There are different light sources

Dark is the absence of light.

That light can be reflected by different materials.

The size of shadows can change depending on where the light source is.
