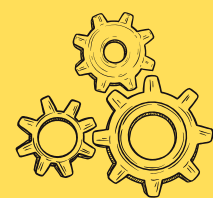

CRUCIAL KNOWLEDGE

The purpose of setting description: To transport the audience to the location.

Describe what a noun, adjective, verb and preposition is.

Language that appeals to different senses to describe the setting.

How to show the setting through the character's eyes. E.g. Hugo scanned the room searching for the guard.

GPS

Use prepositions to direct the reader to different areas of the setting e.g. on the shelf/near the window etc.

Use nouns, adjectives and verbs

KEY VOCABULARY

Noun	A word that names a person, place, thing or idea.
Adjective	A word that describes a noun.
Verb	A doing or being word.

Adverb	We can use adverbs to describe how somebody does something. They describe verbs.
Preposition	Help us to describe the position of something in relation to something else in time or space.
