CRUCIAL KNOWLEDGE

Hazards or risks may be accompanied by a warning sign or symbol.

- There are steps we can take to reduce risks and hazards.
- Our actions have consequences.
- Peer pressure is when someone is putting pressure on you.
- The emergency services can be contacted in an emergency by dialling 999.

EXTENDED KNOWLEDGE

Know what key information to give on a 999 call.

KEY VOCABULARY

Danger	Likely to cause harm or injury. Something that is not safe.
Consequence	A result or effect. It can be unpleasant.
Warning signs/flags	A symbol, sign or flag used to draw attention to a problem or hazard.

Water safety	The procedures, precautions and policies associated with bodies of water.
Sttrategy	A plan into place to achieve a goal.
Peer pressure	Peer pressure is doing something you feel uncomfortable about, because everyone else is.
Risk	Something that could have a bad outcome.
